Warriner Extras

Would you be prepared to give time or expertise to improve and enhance the experience of students at The Warriner School?

Many Primary Schools have thriving Parent Teacher Associations but, when students move to Secondary School, there is not usually the same opportunity for parents to contribute. These 'extras' will be prepared, occasionally, to offer their time and skills to work on projects identified by the school, providing things that are above and beyond the curriculum (extras). This could be something as straightforward as painting a classroom or planting some bulbs but could be as complex as planning a new building or sports facility.

This could simply be time but could be expertise that the school would otherwise have to pay for. I will then compile a database of volunteers and liaise with the school as to how we might contribute. My hope is that the group will be large enough that it will not fall upon the same people to be involved in every project so please encourage others to get in touch too. Projects will inevitably cost money so there will be a fund-raising aspect to the organisation, but no jumble sales I promise.
