**Biometric recognition systems** 

Where we use pupils' biometric data as part of an automated biometric recognition system (for example, pupils use finger prints to receive school dinners instead of paying with cash we will comply with the requirements of the <u>Protection of Freedoms Act 2012</u>.

The School has appointed Harrison Catering Services Ltd (the "Caterer") to provide a school meals service to its pupils and staff. In pursuance of this legitimate interest the school will share relevant personal data with the Caterer, including pupil name, class and dietary requirements. The Caterer is required to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation in the processing of the personal data.

Parents/carers will be notified before any biometric recognition system is put in place or before their child first takes part in it. The school will get written consent from at least one parent or carer before we take any biometric data from their child and first process it.

Parents/carers and pupils have the right to choose not to use the school's biometric system(s). We will provide alternative means of accessing the relevant services for those pupils. For example, pupils can pay for school dinners using a code issued to them.

In line with the GDPR we will also seek explicit written consent from the student to process their biometric data from the age of 12 (where they have the capacity to give that consent).

Parents/carers and pupils can object to participation in the school's biometric recognition system(s), or withdraw consent, at any time, and we will make sure that any relevant data already captured is deleted.

As required by law, if a pupil from the age of 12 refuses to participate in, or continue to participate in, the processing of their biometric data, we will not process that data irrespective of any consent given by the pupil's parent(s)/carer(s).
