Guitar Tuition



When are guitar lessons?

They are on Tuesday and Wednesday. Lesson times move around so that you don't miss the same school curriculum lessons every week.

How much are the guitar lessons?

They are £15 per individual 30 mins, £7.50 for a shared lesson.

What do I need to bring to my first lesson?

Just bring yourself and your instrument and any music that you have previously learnt. Parents will need to sign a contact/terms form before lessons begin.

You will need to give me a term's notice to stop your lessons – but it's advisable to try it for at least 6 months; enough time to feel comfortable with the instrument.
