My approach to lessons is to make them fun and enjoyable with a relaxed manner whilst at the same time pushing the students to reach their full potential. For those who prefer to do Grades in guitar I use ABRSM, Trinity and Rockschool examination boards.

When are guitar lessons?

They are on a Monday morning from 9am until midday. Lesson times move around so that you don't miss the same bit of same lesson every week.
