My qualifications include BSc Hons in Music Technology, Diploma in Contemporary Vocal Teaching, BTEC in Popular Music, Grade 8 Singing and Grade 5 Music Theory. I am the lead singer in a professional functions band and perform in a local musical theatre group.

The lessons will teach the pupil to warm up correctly, adopt good posture and understand breath control; all fundamentals for learning to sing and to sing well. Vocal exercises will help to increase vocal range, strength and confidence. And finally of course we'll learn complete songs and to continue to enjoy singing!

When are lessons?

Every Friday during term time.

Lesson times rotate so that you don't miss the same school subject lesson every week.

How much are the lessons?

£16 per one to one 30 minute lesson. Payable per term in advance.

You will also need to pay for any music books that you need and exam entry fees if opted to.
