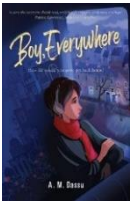
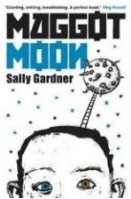

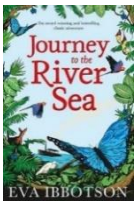
Boy, Everywhere, by AM Dassu

The story of Sami, a Syrian boy who is forced to leave his home with nothing when war strikes.



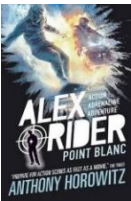
Maggot Moon, by Sally Gardner

Combines conspiracy theory and dystopia. This is also a story full of hope, and speaks compellingly about the value of friendship, trust, courage and freedom.



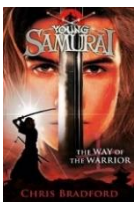
Journey to the River Sea, by Eva Ibbotson

Orphan Maia is ecstatic to learn she is to live with relatives in South America and cannot wait to experience the sights, sounds and smells of the Amazon.



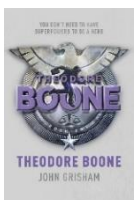
Alex Rider: Point Blanc, by Anthony Horowitz

Alex Rider is plucked from his life as an average schoolboy to pit his wits as a spy for MI6 against the frightening Doctor Grief and his evil plans.



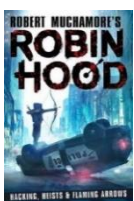
Young Samurai: The Way of the Warrior, by Chris Bradford
