Dear Parent, Carer or Guardian of Year 11

End of Year 11 – All you need to know.

As the time draws ever closer to when your child's GCSE exams start and your child finishes his or her time with us in Year 11, I just want to update you with some information.

Firstly, though, I would like to say that I have seen real progress with the majority of Year 11 students, so 'Thank You' for your continued support at this challenging time.

Year 11 students were given their GCSE Exam timetables this week, so please ask to see them and talk them through with your child.

To clarify, Year 11 students will be in school full time with us until the end of this term: Friday 25th May. They will be in their classes right up until this day even though exams start at the end of April. The expectation is that students will either be in exams or lessons, being taught right up until the end of Term 6. All uniform and behaviour rules absolutely still apply to all students.

After the May Half Term holiday, exams start again on Monday 4th June and it is from this date that your child will only come in to school for their exams, in full uniform and abiding by all the usual school regulations. Please can I ask for your support in this matter; if your child turns up wearing the incorrect uniform, or no uniform or inappropriate jewellery/piercings/make-up, they will be challenged by staff, even possibly having to be isolated in another room for the exam. I am sure you can imagine this will be upsetting and disruptive all round and these are not ideal conditions for exam success, so, again, please ensure that your child arrives in school appropriately dressed for their exams. There will also be areas for your child to revise in the school if he or she has a gap between exams on the same day; in the library for example, there will be Chill Zones for exam students.

On Thursday 21st June, after the exams are completed, students will be invited to attend our Stand Down celebrations – where they will have a year group photograph, BBQ and a chance to say goodbye to each other and staff. Mr. Rafferty is organising this event and it will begin at approximately 12 noon until 3pm. Lastly, on Friday 22nd June, in the evening, invited students will attend a Prom to celebrate the official end of their exams and Year 11. Mrs Angie Blyth is the Prom organiser and it is being held again at Bo Peep Farm venue, at 7pm. Of course there will be lots of other activities taking place over the next few months but the above information is most key – especially for your planning. Please keep an eye on our website, where all information will be posted and where any changes to timings will be advertised.
