Year 8 History Visit to the Black Country Living Museum

The History Department is organising a fieldtrip for the whole of Year 8 to the Black Country Living Museum on either

Wednesday 14th March East
or **Thursday 15th March West**

The visit is part of a unit of work on Industrialisation and it would therefore be beneficial for students to go. It will take place entirely in school time and we hope to be back in time for school buses at 3.00 p.m. I am asking for a voluntary parental contribution of **£17.70** to cover the cost of entry fee, insurance and travel. If not enough contributions are received the visit will have to be cancelled.

Students will need to be in full school uniform and should bring with them food, water, a waterproof coat and umbrella. Students will have the opportunity to experience a 19th Century coal mine. The coal mine experience is supervised by trained staff and safety helmets are provided. Good behaviour is paramount and students must listen carefully to instructions. The students will also visit all the many other points of interest at the Museum, including a 19th Century Fairground. These rides are licensed and regularly checked by experienced staff at the Museum.

Please note participation on the trip is subject to good behaviour in school. Students may be removed from the trip at any point due to bad behaviour.
