### ***What should I do if I test positive for Covid 19?***

*Self-isolating (staying at home) is not a legal requirement if someone has covid-19 (coronavirus) symptoms or has tested positive. However, please use your professional judgement and consider how ill you are feeling. Try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days after the day you took your test if you are 18 years old or over.*

***For under 18s*** the advice is 3 days. Avoid meeting people who are more likely to get seriously ill from viruses, such as people with a weakened immune system.
