The PE department will be offering a carousel of 'Alternate Sports' - activities they may not have come across before, to try out throughout the day.

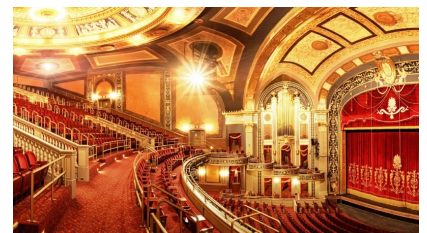
### **Wednesday 10th and Thursday 11th June 2020**
