We are excited to tell you that this year's Year 11 Prom will be held at Cotswold Hotel and Spa, Chipping Norton. We require a £10.00 deposit to secure your child's place. Payment is also an acknowledgment of giving permission for your child to attend and accepting responsibility to ensure they are picked up at the end of the evening.

Tickets are £50.00 each and payment to be made via ParentPay. This will cover the cost of the venue, welcome drinks, canapes, a buffet main and a sit-down dessert. It also includes music, entertainment, decorations. A bar selling non-alcoholic drinks will be open throughout the evening. Students will need to bring money with them to pay for further drinks. There is also a professional photographer, so photographs of the arrival and evening are available to purchase after the event.

Payment:


- £10.00 non-refundable deposit payable on ParentPay by Friday 15th December 2023.
- The remaining £40.00 can be paid with the deposit or in £10.00 instalments providing the final payment is received by 23rd May.
- Reminders will be sent out periodically regarding how much you have left to pay.

Later, we will send out further information regarding the Prom in terms of menu options, arrival times and seating. In the meantime, if students have any questions, with regards to these elements please email Mr Rafferty.

A place at the Prom is a privilege and as such, is subject to students following our Attitude to Learning and Behaviour policy. Indeed, some students will not have immediate access to a place at the Prom due to current behaviour and a discussion with a senior teacher will be needed before this is potentially granted. Conduct will be monitored closely, and in some cases, students will have their right to Prom revoked. This decision will be reviewed termly.











Therefore, ultimately, the school reserves the right to remove any student from the Prom who fails to meet our expectations. A refund of the price of the ticket will be given to any student who is then excluded from the event and a Prom ticket will not be issued.

However, we very much hope that many of our fantastic Year 11 students will join us next June to celebrate the end of their GCSEs and their 11-16 education and the beginning of the next part of their educational journey.
