Year 7 – Student Runners

Year 7 students are encouraged to become a “runner” on reception duty during their first academic year. We put together a schedule of “runners” to commence after the October holiday as they will have had one term in school to become familiar with their surroundings. Year 7 students are put into pairs, they do not work alone.

On their assigned days, students will be instructed to go to their timetabled lesson each period to pick up any work which they are expected to complete whilst on duty. They are given the responsibility to complete tasks and jobs as assigned by our reception personnel.

The rationale for this duty is to develop students’ self-esteem, giving them confidence and responsibility and increasing their knowledge of the school site. It is a practice adopted by many schools. Students are used mainly for taking important messages around the school, although the nature of the day does vary depending upon need.
