If you are receiving this letter your child is most likely in receipt of Pupil Premium. We spend a lot of this funding on staffing to support our students. However, we do keep aside some money to support families. We can help with:

1. Equipment or uniform: Usually we can set up payment plans to spread some of the costs.
2. School trips: Whilst we cannot fully fund trips, we can partly support with some of the costs, and again we can arrange payment plans to help meet costs
3. Catch up: We can support attendance and access to after school catch up clubs
4. Access: We can support with transport arrangements, or we can offer the on-going support of one of our attendance team. We cannot fund transport for long periods of time. Funding here is for short term, emergency relief.
5. Clubs: we can support access and places for Pupil Premium students
6. Contact: we can support by providing staff to support day to day school life. The staff we provide work in different departments to support different needs.

It is important to say that each year we spend more than we get from the government. This means funding can be tight. As a result we need to take each request on a case by case basis and we need to ensure that we are as fair as possible.
