In what ways [8]	Two paragraphs, explain, try to show change over time
Which of the following [12]	Provide a judgement in the opening sentence, write about the most important bullet point first (one paragraph), provide a link between the two bullet points, write about the other bullet point (one paragraph), conclude. Total = 3 paragraphs

Remember:

4 marks = 5 minutes = one paragraph

8 marks = 10 minutes = two paragraphs

12 marks = 15 minutes = three paragraphs

16 marks = 20 minutes = four paragraphs
