We regularly track student attendance and make contact home where we have concerns. It is not only important learning and personal development that your child misses, but also opportunities to be with their peers and build friendships. Please ensure your child attends school unless they have a genuine reason for absence.

If your child has become reluctant to attend school, there tends to be good reasons why and good bedtime routines help. Please take the time to listen to your child, share any concerns you or your child may have with the child's mentor, Assistant Head of Year, Head of Year or our Attendance Liaison Team and seek support at the very earliest opportunity.
