| The Puzzle of Ethics – Peter Vardy/Paul Grosch: | Good read, not a textbook. |
| Understand Ethics – Mel Thompson: | Again, a read not a textbook. Nicely organised and easy to follow. |
| Ethical Studies – Robert Bowie: | One of my favourites - a good reader but also includes clear summaries and questions. |
| OCR Religious Ethics for AS and A2 – Jill Oliphant: | Really comprehensive but at the same time quite full-on! I tend to photocopy the bits I think you'll find useful. |
| Ethics for OCR Religious Studies – Mark Coffey/Dennis Brown: | Also includes both AS and A2. Again, not one I recommend you buy yourself unless you really like it! |
| OCR AS Philosophy and Ethics – Ina Taylor (ed) | Textbook; simple explanations and tasks. Colour and with pictures! Doesn't cover things in depth. |
| Ethical Theory – Mel Thompson: | Clear presentation, good textbook. Includes Key words, key thoughts, key people, key quotes sections. |
| AS & A Level Phil & Ethics Through Diagrams – Greg Dewar: | Just because it says 'through diagrams', doesn't make it clear/concise! Good in parts. |
| AS Ethics Revision Guide for OCR – Peter Baron: | Broken down into simple summaries. QR codes to link to web resources. |
