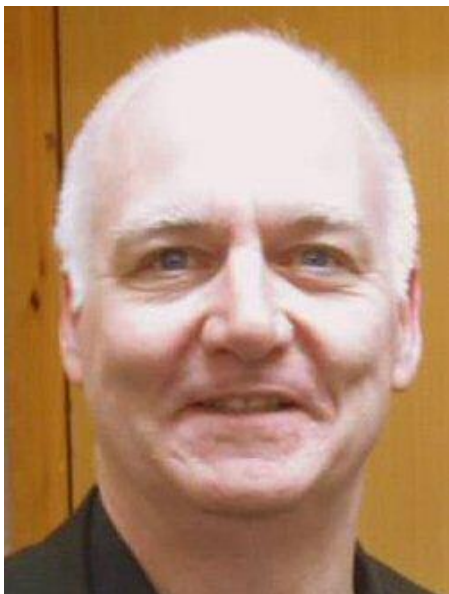


The Warriner School Instrumental Teaching – Music Department



My name is Nick Planas and I am a woodwind teacher at Warriner School. I have been a teacher for over twenty-six years. I am also a composer of orchestral music, a conductor, and a regular performer on flute, clarinet and saxophone.

I teach students of all ages from beginner up to Grade 8 and beyond.

I use both the ABRSM and Trinity exam boards, and also encourage students to take music theory exams to enhance their musical knowledge.

When are woodwind lessons?

To begin with I will be teaching on a Wednesday afternoon – this may change over the next year. Lesson times move around so that you don't miss the same bit of same lesson every week.

How much are the lessons?

They are £18.00 per individual 30 minutes. For complete beginners I am happy to provide shared lessons (2 students) for the first year. Most of my students set up a monthly rolling payment plan with me, which spreads the cost over the whole school year.

What do I need to bring to my first lesson?

Just bring yourself (with a big smile!) and your instrument and any music that you have previously learnt.

What if I don't like learning and want to stop

You will need to give me a month's notice to stop your lessons – but please try to persist. The early steps are often quite hard until you can get a good sound; I know - it took me a few lessons to get a flute to make a proper sound!
