Trevor has been teaching piano at Warriner School for two years and has a growing list of successful students, many of whom have achieved a steady stream of excellent results in Piano Grades and Theory of Music. He has also coached students for A level performance.

Each student finds their own path and there is no compulsion to take exams as some students prefer to learn through a progressive course, such as <u>Piano Adventures</u>, a student centred, broadly based learning programme, (<u>www.pianoadventures.com</u>).

There are many styles of piano playing, all built on the same basic foundation of musical knowledge and technique. Trevor draws on a broad repertoire encompassing both classical and modern styles, which is also reflected in the exam syllabuses.

Creativity plays an important role in the learning process and students are encouraged to compose from the very outset. Also technology provides a whole range of learning support to help the student practice at home.

When do lessons take place?

Wednesdays and Thursdays throughout the school day. Lesson times are rotated to minimise the impact on your child's regular timetable. You will receive an email reminder three days beforehand.

Do I need a piano?

Ideally, yes, but many students start off by learning the basics on a keyboard. I do have a few available for loan. Beware of second hand pianos and always seek advice!
