Revision Tips

Makes notes during revision – When taking notes, you should summarise large paragraphs. Firstly, you should read the paragraph and try and digest the information. Secondly, you should pick out what you think are the key points. Finally, you should try to write a summary of the paragraph in your own words without looking, being sure to add your key points to remember.

<u> Attendance Matters — A Polite Reminder</u>


There is a clear link between good school attendance and progress. Please support your child to maximise their attendance. In Year 11 we will be expecting students to have an attendance of 97% or more. Those with attendance below 93% are likely to achieve one GCSE grade lower per subject than those with higher attendance. If their attendance is lower than 90% they are labelled by the government as a 'persistent absentee' and are likely to achieve two grades lower per subject.
