## HPV Vaccination at THE WARRINER SCHOOL

**HPV1 (Year 8): 14/03/2022**

**HPV2 (Year 9): 08/04/2022**

Further to our correspondence at the end of last term we can confirm that the School Aged Immunisation Team will be attending your child's school to deliver the HPV vaccinations to students in Year 8 and Year 9, for whom we have consent, on the date(s) above. If you have not yet received the consent form, please contact your child's school. If you have difficulty accessing the electronic consent form or your child no longer requires this vaccination, please call 07920 254 400 for further help.

### Year 8 students due HPV1 Vaccination

If your child is in Year 8 and you agree for them to receive the HPV vaccine at school, you must have completed the online consent form which was sent out via schools in the Winter term of 2021. If you have already submitted a consent form for your child, please **DO NOT** submit the form again unless any details on the form have changed. If you are unsure if a Consent Form was submitted, please check for the confirmation email from [noreply@cinnamondigitalapplications.co.uk](mailto:noreply@cinnamondigitalapplications.co.uk).

**Please note** If your child moves to a school outside Oxfordshire before receiving their second dose in Year 9, please contact your local School Health Nurse Immunisation Service in that area for advice to ensure the course is completed.

### Year 9 students due HPV2 Vaccination

If your child is in Year 9 and due HPV 2, please **DO NOT** submit a further consent form unless your child has developed any allergies, medical conditions, commenced any medication or has already had their second dose since they were in Year 8. If your child **has not** received their first dose (HPV1) please call 07920 254 400 for further help.
