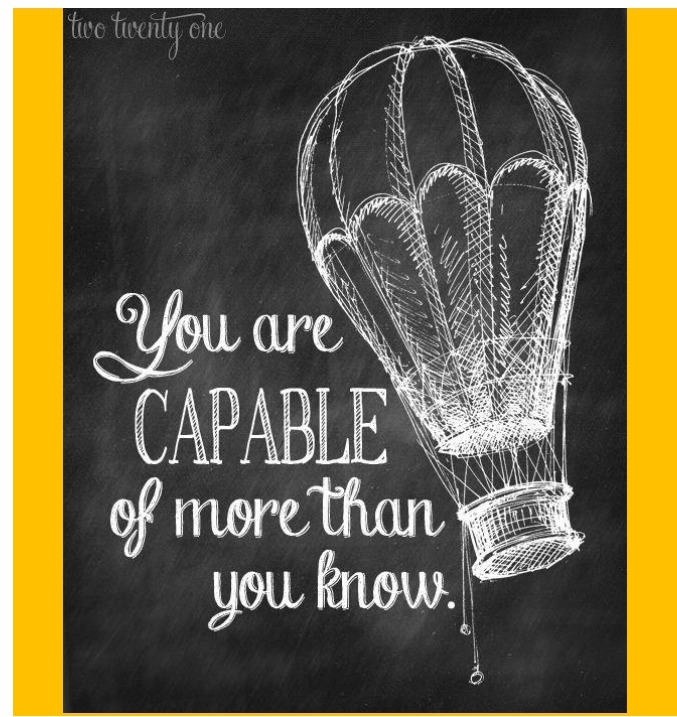

## Year 11 Leavers Celebration Afternoon Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June – 12.20pm (Main Hall)

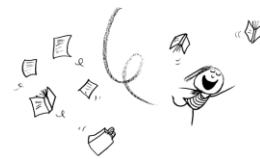
