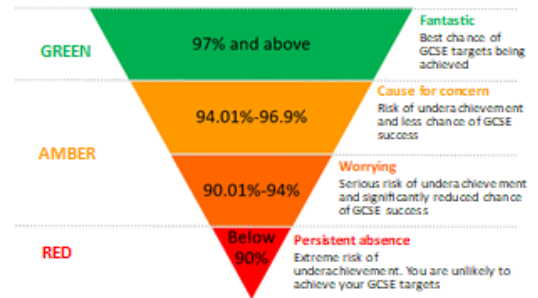


Attendance Update – March 2023

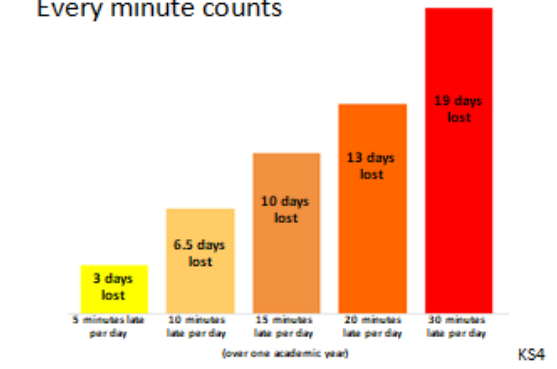
We continue to promote good attendance and were pleased to see an improvement in overall attendance in Term 3. Students from Term 3 with 97-100% attendance or most improving attendance will be receiving their rewards and certificates over the coming weeks. In total, over 600 certificates have been printed!

We also ask that you continue support us with good time-keeping. As our posters show, just being late 5 minutes per day equates to missing 3 school days over the academic year.

At the beginning of this term we opened our new Attendance Liaison Office. This new office is located in the Admin block next door to the staff room entrance. Ms Lowe, our Attendance Officer, and Ms Timms, our Attendance Support Worker, are based in this office. This gives our Attendance Team the privacy to meet with students and/or parents to discuss issues relating to school attendance.

One of the key changes that students need to be aware of is that the late signing in book will now be located in the new Attendance Liaison Office until 10am every day (after this time it will move back to the General Office). If you drop your child off late, please remind them of this new procedure (and our colleagues will redirect them if they forget). This starts on Monday 6th March.

Finally, later this term we will be running an attendance incentive using a spinning wheel to randomly select a winning tutor group and everyone present during tutor time that day will receive a reward. All students in school during this time have a chance to be in a winning tutor group and the prizes will be delivered during tutor time.
