

WARRINER TRANSPORT INFORMATION 2023

As your year 6 student starts their journey to The Warriner we want you to be assured of their safety on route to school.

Our transport operators have all been DBS checked and have worked in educational transport for many years. We liaise regularly with OCC and the transport providers to ensure that everyone is providing the service we expect. In return the transport providers keep us informed of changes, road closures, accidents and lateness and in turn we will keep parents informed.

In the event of a late bus in the afternoon a group call message will be sent to parents. If a bus has an issue on route then a replacement will be sent.

Please be assured that your son/daughters safety is of paramount importance and therefore regular unannounced Department of Transport checks are completed on all our buses/coaches.

If you have applied for your free school transport then your bus pass will be sent out to you from O.C.C in the month of August 2023

If your child has not been offered free home to school transport but you wish to apply for a paid seat on bus services provided by Oxfordshire County Council, please complete an application form and send to spareseatsscheme@oxfordshire.gov.uk. To assist the Spare Seats Scheme in processing the applications in time for travel in September please ensure completed applications are returned by July 2023.


