

Attendance Update – June 2023

We continue to promote good attendance and expect students to attend school as normal when school is open. We wish to reassure you that when school is closed due to situations out of our control (eg strike days), these are not recorded as absences on your child's record.

With the good weather and less illnesses that we often experience in the summer term, we are aiming for excellent attendance this term to boost over overall attendance statistics for the year.

As always attendance certificates are being produced for students who achieved 97% or above attendance or most improved attendance during Term 5. This term we printed almost 500 certificates for students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12.



Our Warriner Wheel attendance incentive is continuing to be popular, and it was spun a few times last term with the students in the winning tutor groups receiving a treat. It will run again on random days this term so 'students have got to be in to win'.



This term's main attendance incentive will run in the last two weeks of term, w/c 10th and 17th July. Everyone who achieves 100% attendance in either week will be entered into a prize draw for the chance to win prizes such as swimming vouchers, days out vouchers or movie night hampers.
