Conditions for cycling to The Warriner School

- Students must wear named cycle helmets and bright or reflective clothing
- Bicycles must be in good working order and well maintained
- Bicycles must be fitted with a bell and working lights
- Students must hold a Cycle Permit signed by a parent/carer, giving permission to cycle to school alone
